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Bellflower Unified School District **GATE Enrichment Program** for Students (Grades 3-6)

The Bellflower Unified School District is proudly offering a six week Gate Enrichment Program for the second and third trimester this school year. Students have the opportunity to participate in one of the enrichment classes listed below per trimester.

The classes are held at sites throughout the district. Parents are responsible for transporting their student to and from the class. Students will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. During the winter session, classes will be held January 26, 2015 through March 6, 2015 with a make-up week to accommodate holidays or instructor absence (if any) during March 9-13, 2015.

During the spring session, classes will be held March 16, 2016 through May 1, 2015 with a make-up week to accommodate instructor absence (if any) during May 4-8. 2015. No classes will be held during Spring Break, April 6-10, 2015.

WHAT IS THE GATE ENRICHMENT PROGRAM?



The BUSD GATE Program is for students in third through sixth grades.

The Bellflower Unified School District proudly offers the GATE Enrichment Program for all BUSD GATE identified students. GATE students throughout the district will have the opportunity to select an enrichment class on a first come, first served basis. This pro-

gram allows our highest achieving students the opportunity to extend their regular classroom learning and engage in rich meaningful educational experiences. The program may also generate early interest in specialized or elective programs.

HOW CAN MY CHILD PARTICIPATE?

Each student identified in the GATE program may participate in the Enrichment Program. Classes are offered during the second and third trimesters of the school year. Students may choose to attend a class at their own elementary site or to join a class from another elementary school site. Students may take one class each trimester. Please note that district transportation will not be provided.

HOW CAN WE SIGN UP?

Parents or guardians submit a permission slip for students to participate in the program. Completed permission slips will indicate student's first, second and third choices for each trimester and emergency contact information. Permission slips will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Please turn in this permission slip to your child's school office.

WHERE CAN WE OBTAIN A PERMISSION SLIP?

WHAT ARE CLASS TIMES?

Each session is six weeks long. Classes held on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday are $3:30~\rm pm$ - $4:30~\rm pm$. Wednesday's class sessions are $2:00~\rm pm$ - $3:00~\rm pm$.

It is essential that your child be on time to class. If students arrive late or do not attend class, students on the waiting list will be given priority.

HOW WILL I KNOW IF MY CHILD IS ENROLLED INTO AN ENRICHMENT CLASS?

Parents or guardians will receive a confirmation letter by January 10, 2015. School offices will also have enrollment lists for your information.

Unfilled classes will be cancelled.

WHAT ARE THE CLASSES AVAILABLE?

HOW WILL I BE NOTIFIED IF A CLASS IS CANCELLED?

Parents will be notified by phone call or email if the class is cancelled. It is BUSD's expectation that all classes will be held. If a regularly scheduled class is cancelled, it will be held during the make up week.

WHAT SHOULD I EXPECT FOR THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS?

Teachers will take attendance and begin immediately. Any students on the waiting list will be admitted if there are no shows and there is space in the class.

PARENT/GUARDIAN PICK UP It is expected that students will be dropped off and picked up from class on time.
